This guide is to support learning at home where school is still open, but a family is self-isolating and the child is not unwell.

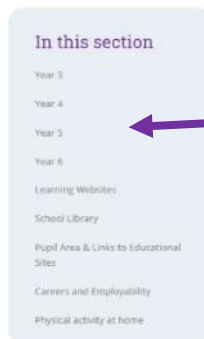
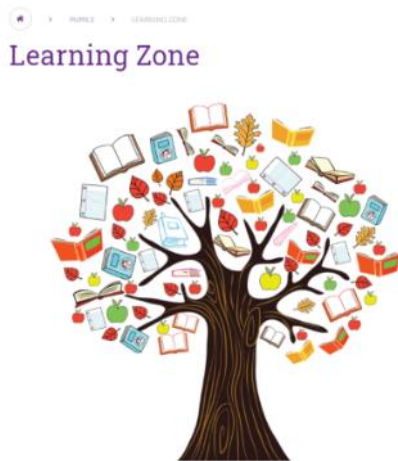

Then scroll to the 'Home Learning' section.



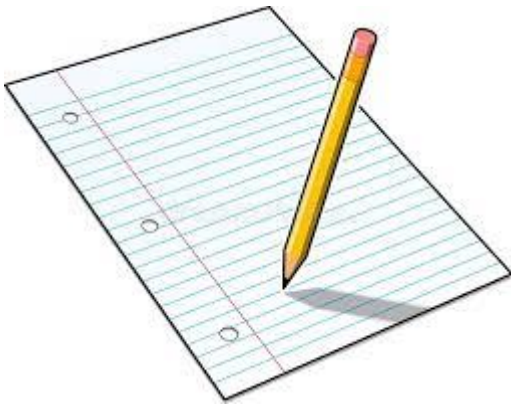
