

# DANESHOLME JUNIOR ACADEMY

## **Uniform Policy**

The Danesholme Junior Academy has strict guidelines on school dress and all pupils are expected to wear the full Academy uniform. We believe that wearing our distinctive uniform gives our pupils a sense of belonging and fosters pride in the Academy. Pupils are our ambassadors in the community. Therefore, we expect all pupils to wear full uniform when travelling to and from the Academy, at all Academy functions, on extra-curricular visits and when taking part in sports events.

The wearing of our distinctive uniform gives pupils a sense of 'belonging', helps foster pride in the Academy and stops pupils coming to school in inappropriate clothing or footwear. There are also basic uniform requirements which must always be adhered to.

These basic requirements are:

- Shoes must be black, sensible ones for Academy use, flat soled or with very low heels. **No trainers are allowed**.
- We will not allow tattoos, make-up, jewellery, nail varnish, false nails, dyed hair or hair extensions.
- Excessive hair styles are strongly discouraged and decisions about the suitability of an individual style are the responsibility of the Principal, whose decision will be final. 'Cuts' of any shape or design are not allowed, nor are multiple hair colours. We recommend that long hair is tied back. All hair accessories should be modest.
- Jewellery is not allowed, other than one pair of plain earring studs worn in the earlobe. Other types of earrings, rings, nose studs or other facial jewellery are not allowed.

### Uniform for pupils in Years 3 and 4

- Academy polo shirt with logo and collar stripes\*
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Academy jumper or cardigan, in purple, with the Academy logo
- Black, grey or socks/tights
- Purple checked summer dress, or tailored shorts in warmer weather
- Academy book bag or small plain rucksack
- Sensible black shoes (no trainers)
- A warm coat for travelling to and from the Academy and playtimes.
- Children should have a waterproof coat with them every day.

\* Parents may also buy plain, white polo shirts

### Uniform for pupils in Years 5 and 6


- Plain white school shirt (not polo shirts) with full button-up collar
- Academy tie
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Academy jumper or cardigan, in purple, with the Academy logo
- Black, grey or white socks/tights
- Purple checked summer dress, or tailored shorts in warmer weather
- Academy book bag or small plain rucksack
- Sensible black shoes (not trainers)
- A warm coat for travelling to and from the Academy and playtimes.
- Children should have a waterproof coat with them every day.

#### PE kit for all pupils

- Academy PE bag
- Academy sports polo shirt
- Academy black shorts
- A pair of plimsolls or trainers for outdoor PE
- A plain black tracksuit

PE kit should not have branded sports logos.

Earrings must be removed for PE lessons and sporting activities.
